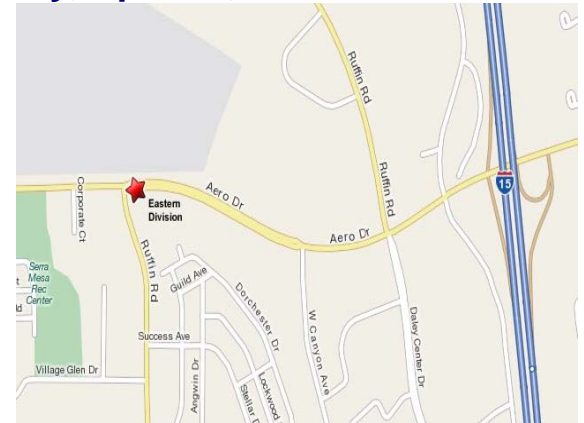




**Pre-registration is now closed; however, VOLUNTEERS ARE STILL WELCOME!
